It's time to put NMNWSE's Technical Symposium and Annual Meeting on your calendar!

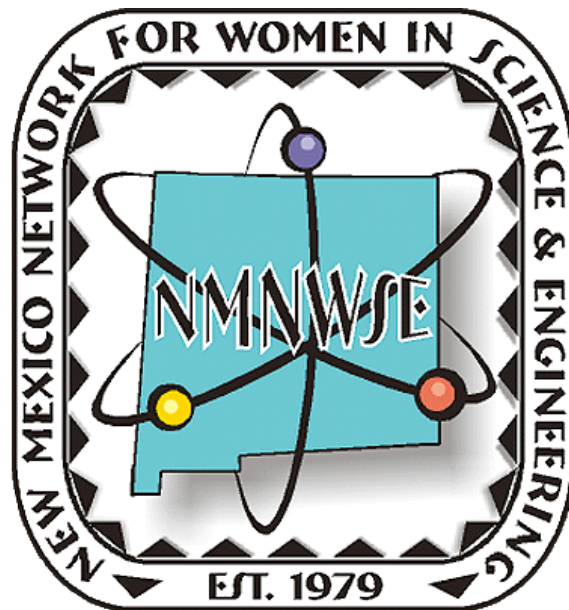
