



This year's meeting will be held in Alamogordo, NM, "the friendliest place on earth". Alamogordo boasts scenic attractions such as White Sands National Monument as well as scientific attractions such as the New Mexico Space History Museum which stresses the role the state of New Mexico has played in the development of the U.S. Space Program.

The meeting begins with a Friday evening reception at the NM Space History Museum, with the Museum open for our browsing. Saturday morning is the annual business meeting of the Network, followed by technical talks in the early afternoon. The late afternoon features the poster session, an excellent opportunity to network – students, teachers, and non-employed members presenting posters are eligible for a meeting scholarship. Saturday ends with dinner at the Historic Tulie Cantina in Tularosa, featuring presentation of the **2012 NMNWSE IMPACT! Award**, and an after-dinner program. Members are invited to stay though Sunday for the first meeting of the new state Board, elected at the business meeting on Saturday.
