This year's meeting will be held at the Shaffer Hotel, a registered National Historical site and one of the few Pueblo-Deco buildings still in existence. Mountainair, a gem of the Old West, is nestled among charming Spanish towns along the picturesque Manzano Mountains. Mountainair is now home to many fine art galleries and studios, but still allows visitors to "step back in time" and is a delight to train enthusiasts. At the nearby Salinas Pueblo Missions National Monument you'll find three ancient Indian pueblos sites and the ruins of majestic 17th century Spanish mission churches.

The meeting begins with a Friday evening reception. Saturday morning is the annual business meeting of the Network. Lunch features a talk on the Salinas Pueblo Missions, followed by a tour in the early afternoon. The late afternoon features the technical session - an excellent opportunity to network! Students, teachers, and non-employed members presenting posters are eligible for a meeting scholarship. Saturday ends with dinner at the Alpine Alley Restaurant and presentation of the **2013 NMNWSE IMPACT! Award** (see announcement in this flyer).

Members are invited to stay though Sunday for the first meeting of the new state Board, elected at Saturday's Business Meeting.



Registration is now open. The meeting cost is \$85 including lunch and dinner on Saturday. Early registration closes 10 Oct 2013, with late registrations accepted through the meeting date on a space-available basis.


