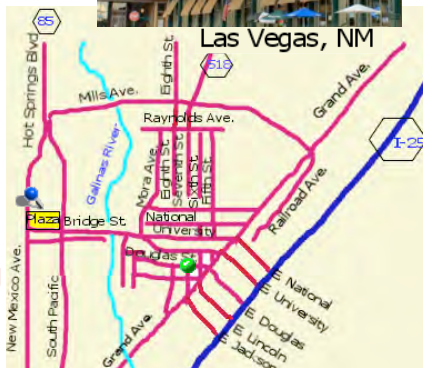

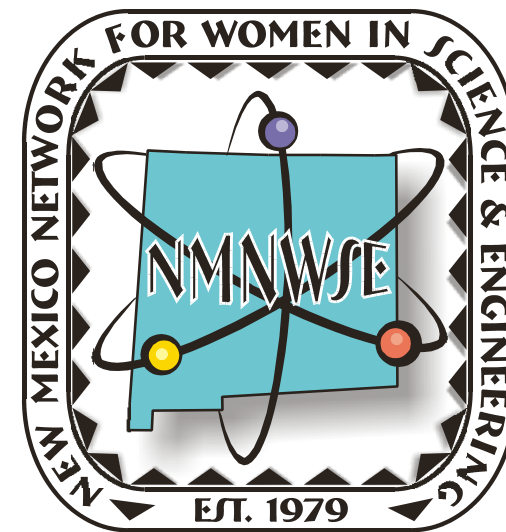

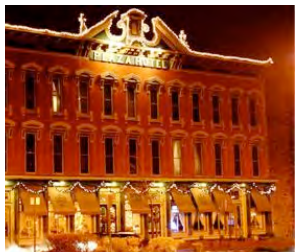

This year's meeting will be held at the historic Plaza Hotel, called "The Belle of the Southwest" when it was built in 1882. Lovingly restored a century later and listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this magnificent hotel, suspended gracefully in the past, presides regally over the Old Town Plaza in Las Vegas, NM.

The meeting begins with a Friday evening reception. Saturday morning is the annual business meeting of the Network - all members are encouraged to attend. After lunch there will be a tour of a nearby university focusing on their STEM education and outreach programs (details TBA). The late afternoon features technical talks, followed by a poster session/reception before dinner - an excellent opportunity to network and for students to present their work in a supportive environment! Saturday ends with the conference dinner at *Dick's Pub and Grill* featuring presentation of the **2014 NMNWSE IMPACT! Award** (see call for nominations in this flyer), followed by a talk highlighting research done at one of the local universities (speaker TBA).

Members are invited to stay though Sunday for the first meeting of the new state Board, elected at Saturday's Business Meeting.

Registration will open as soon as costs finalized (anticipated Sep 1). The registration fee is expected to be under \$100, including lunch and dinner on Saturday, receptions, and snacks. Early registration will close 3 October 2014, with late registrations accepted through the meeting date on a space-available basis (\$10 late fee applies).

Students, teachers, and non-employed members presenting a poster in Saturday's technical session are eligible for a meeting scholarship to cover the registration fee.

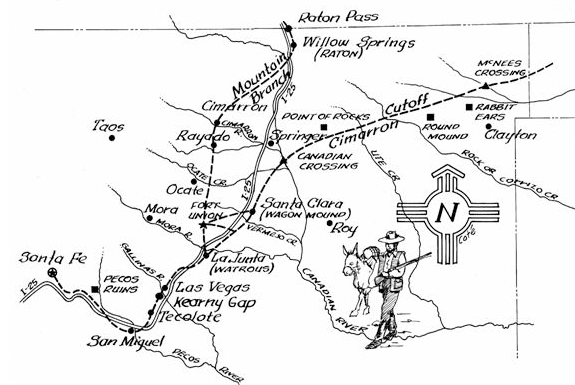
