



## 2015 NMNWE TECHNICAL SYMPOSIUM & BUSINESS MEETING

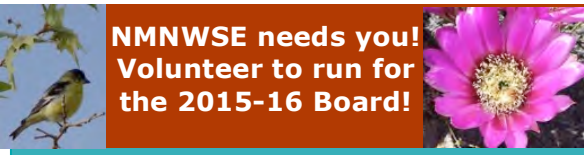

This year's meeting will take place at the Sierra Grande Lodge and Spa in Truth or Consequences, NM. Sierra County, with its soothing hot springs, scenic mountain and desert terrain, mild climate, and the two largest lakes in New Mexico, has long been a preferred vacation spot for New Mexico natives. Nearby, Spaceport America capitalizes on this region's place in the history of rocketry and the aerospace industry.

The meeting begins with a Friday evening reception. Saturday morning is the annual business meeting of the Network – all members are encouraged to attend. The afternoon features technical talks, followed by a poster session/ reception before dinner – an excellent opportunity to network and for students to present their work in a supportive environment! Saturday ends with the conference dinner and presentation of the **2015 NMNWE IMPACT! Award** (see call for nominations in this flyer), followed by a talk (speaker TBA).

Students, teachers, and non-employed members presenting a poster in Saturday's technical session are eligible for a meeting scholarship to cover the registration fee.

Members are invited to stay though Sunday for the first meeting of the 2015-16 state Board, elected at Saturday's Business Meeting.

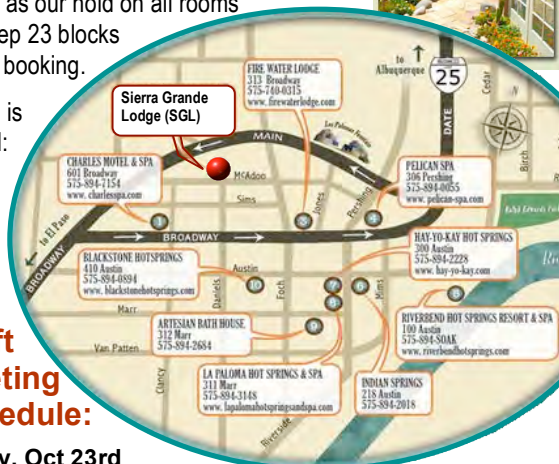

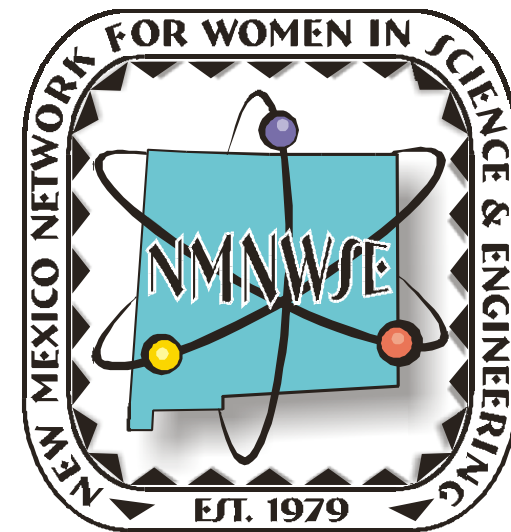
