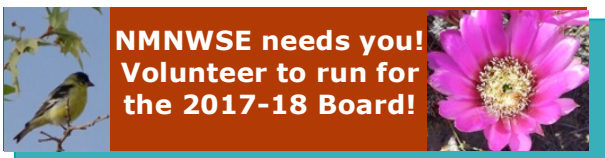
Room charges with the **NMNWSE** group code are \$89, plus tax/fees.

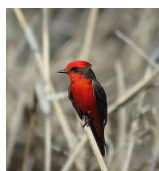

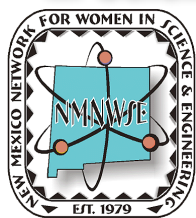

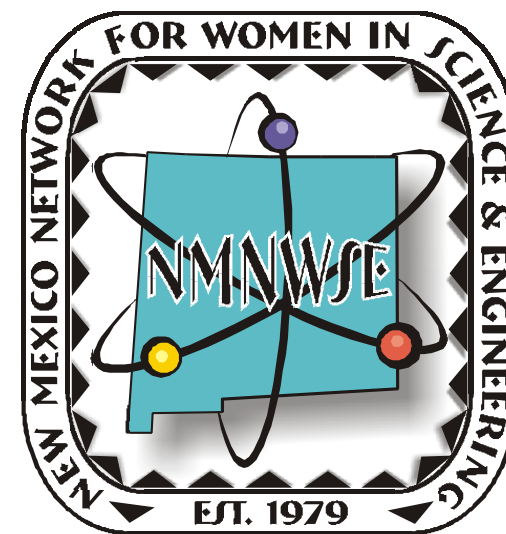
